Role and Nature of the Organisation: This being a philanthropic entity is purely a non-profitable organization set-up involving parents and Guardians of the disabled person accompanying the support of other liberal minded sympathizers to serve for the cause of Mentally Challenged, Spastics, Speech and Audio defectives, Learning disabled along with other associated disabled sector of the Society.

Perspective: It represents an important process for executing a successful safe of social organ to meet the challenge of the presence scenario in respect of mental retardation and to improve its efficiency needed for the benefit of disabled and weaker section of the people.

Profile: Our organization is the outcome of several years of thinking, devotion and earnestness of the parents of the mentally challenged children along with the congenial support of a few sympathizers. Obviously in our journey in this respect we had the opportunity in possessing the bliss and inspiration from Late Dr. B.N.Roy, a distinguished figure in the field of welfare activities.

Since the date of the inception of our organization, professional persons belong to it have been trying their best offering their services for the cause of mentally disabled persons including the person having with other disabilities. Change has become a watchword for successful living and imparting resourceful training and education to the mentally challenged what have also been realized as the tool for yielding accommodative change. In course of training and education, continuous effort is essential for proper development for executing the process. Our resource persons always keep themselves busy in generating their services not only for the mentally retarded but also for the other weaker section of the people having children with some other disabilities. In this respect our chief patron Dr. A.K.Ghosh always give instruction and successful guidelines to the professionals and resource person including members of the parents.

A SURFACE

1. Karunamoyee Parents' Organisation for the mentally handicapped is a registered society under the societies registration act -XXVI, of 1971 bearing no. S/88404, and it also been registered under P.W.D.Act 1995.
2. It was established in 1997 by the parents and guardians of the mentally retarded children in collaboration with other sympathizers for securing various services and support in respect of their mentally challenged wards.
3. **F.C.R.A. -REGISTRATION:** K-POMENCAP has been accorded FCRA 1976, from the Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt.Of INDIA in this year.

THE AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE ORGANISATION:

IMPROVEMENT STATUS PROFILE.

1. To, extend all sorts of support to Mentally Challenged, Spastic, Speech and Audio impaired and intellectual impaired.
It has been observe that disabled persons mentioned above are treated as human waste within the society and their families and thus they are often victimized. But K-POMENCAP is trying its best to change this view with the setting programme of awareness, holding camps and Seminars covering both in rural and urban area.
2. To organise seminar, meetings and short term workshop and training programme involving parents guardians and other members of the societies.
By arranging above programme the organization aims at to full fill their commitment in generating awareness in the public mind so that the non-chalent view maintained by the people towards MR people may reduce significantly.
3. To arranged Home Based Programme and individual training programme for the disabled.
4. To provide information and help the disabled in obtaining the opportunity for self-employment.
5. To set up Residential Care & Respite Care Unit for the MR.
6. To make survey work to detect out the number of disabled people in and around of our area covering from (South & North) 24 Parganas. In this respect 3 of our resource persons have been engaged in DLRO Programme (Govt. of West Bengal) in the field of Mental Retardation, Speech & Hearing Impaired and Visually Handicapped.
7. Keeping abreast of the awareness programme in rural area in every Saturday and Sunday our resource persons are engaged extending their services. It is hoped that the authority of DLRO will come forward in extending it services in near future.
8. To publish literature, brochure, leaflets for creating awareness and mass education. To generate mass awareness and social awareness the organization tresses the utilization of the other media like TV AND Radio programme including Newspaper, talks, discussion and exhibition support.
9. To arrange Parent's Training Programme for the MR associated Disables.

10. To encourage and help to open special school.
- i> For Day school for day scholars - An Institution named by Dr. B.N.Roy memorial Institution for the Disabled had already been setup in Jagatpur, Baguiati, Kolkata - 59. A good number of MR children and other associated disabled are receiving training and education by the professionals and resourceful persons of the Institution. At present 42 Disabled students enrolled and getting Special Education and Vocational training
 - ii> A building with premises has already been possessed by the organization. A respite and rehabilitation center for the MR persons is in process. The location of the building is in Mondal Para Krishnapur, Kolkata.
 - iii> Contemplation is to set up special school in remote village in collaboration with other sister organisation.

PROFILE OF ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN DURING THE YEAR 2003-2004:

For the meaningful learning process K-POMENCAP gives emphasis on the importance of aesthetic, cultural and creative cults of human life in association with other human merits comprising music, dance, yoga, meditation and physical feats. Every week on Saturday day and Sunday the professional of our institution are being engaged to offer community based services for the disabled to the different parts of Hooghly district. From C.B.R. programme we have been able to sensitize a large number of people and make them aware about the baneful malady of "Mental Retardation".

3RD DECEMBER -WORLD DISABLED DAY.

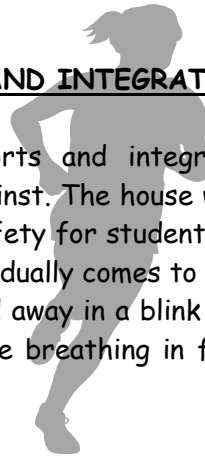
