

Now it gives us immense pleasure to present the annual report for the year 2023-2024. Another eventful year is completed in the history of BEHALA BODHAYAN, which would be ever remembered. The year is meaningful in achieving some milestones in the field of development with our own unique experience and expertise in implementing different development initiatives. ### **Vision & Values**

To usher in a confirming action with the multi-dimensional activities for the protection, care and inclusion of persons with mental retardation, autism, cerebral palsy and multiple disabilities within or close to their own communities with the objectives of exploring and developing their maximum potentialities.

**Behala Bodhayan** pays utmost importance to the values the members believe in. The main objective is to explore and develop the potentials that lie in each individual with special needs to the fullest extent in order to include them in the mainstream of the society.

### Mission

- To facilitate opportunities in order to empower and enable persons with disability through education, vocational training care, inclusive education, income generation and social integration.
- To strengthen families so that after the demise of their parents such children can be taken care of by their legal guardians or other eligible persons of registered organizations.

- To enhance parents' co-operation and association for taking care of children with mental retardation, autism, cerebral palsy and multiple disabilities.
- To develop family support programmed for the children with disabilities which include training of parents and siblings, awareness within the family and relatives in order to keep their environment free from physical and psychological barriers.
- To synergize community people for the need of partnership between governments, persons with disabilities, their families, voluntary organizations, special educators and the main stream of the society.
- To develop comprehensive centers with diagnostics, counseling and therapeutic services, self-help groups, sustainable services, district level information systems and networks and multi-sectoral linkages.

# **Organisational Setup**

Behala Bodhayan is an association of parents of the persons with mental retardation, autism, cerebral palsy & multiple disabilities, forming a Non-Government Non-profit charitable organization for the welfare of such persons with the said disabilities and functioning for the last 14 years.

Our organization primarily engages in running:
$\hfill \Box$ A residential care center which provides boarding and lodging of students.
<ul> <li>A special school (Day Care Centre) for early intervention and providing basic education.</li> </ul>
Vocational training along with other trainings and developments for improvement in their quality of life, rehabilitation, social integration and in order to make themselves self sufficient.
□ Social Service which involves home visits, surveys, need based aids and appliances, therapy, awareness and medical help.
☐ Social Integration Programs which include cultural and vocational activities, awareness workshops and competitions.

# **General Objectives**

- 1. A health care unit specially equipped for children with various different abilities.
- 2. An old age home for elderly persons with disability /parents who are unable to support themselves & their wards/senior citizens who have cultivated interest in the activities of Behala Bodhayan.
- 3. A seminar hall & auditorium for the various cultural activities conducted by Behala Bodhayan.
- 4. Recreational centre with a play-ground, therapeutic and training arrangement.
- 5. Respite care centre with equipments for short stay for the children and their families.

## **Specific Objectives:**

#### Goal oriented Individual Educational Programme

As our organisation deals with students who are mentally retarded hence we a set up individual educational and development programmes & syllabus that suits compatible for particular student.

The School unit divided into 5 classes according to the functional & chronological age of the child.

- 1. **Pre-Primary** Pre-Primary class is the first level of the child in a structured setting with teachers and group of children. The curricular and co-circular to be in sync with child's social, emotional, cognitive, language and physical abilities. This helps our young children to learn according to their abilities.
- 2. **Primary** This class focuses on the socialisation along with functional and prevocational skill development. A few students were speechless and language training which enhanced their speaking abilities.
- 3. **Secondary** Students of this class participated in different cultural programmes and also participated in different in various School competitions and has been awarded with prizes and certificates.
- 4. **Prevocational I** In this class the students are provided with skill-based training to enhance their readiness to work so that they can choose their future job according to their abilities.

- 5. **Prevocational** II We perform almost similar activity as in Prevocational I but on a higher level.
- 6. Vocational In this class we provide various types of vocational training such as
  - a. Junk Jewellery making
  - b. Stitching
  - c. Handicraft of various types
  - d. Greeting Card making
  - e. Food processing

Through these class students are able to learn different vocational skills for future placements.

Apart from the above-mentioned classes we also provide OBE &various Therapies for self-development of the students.

#### **OBE (Open Basic Education)**

The Open Basic Education provides opportunities to the children with special needs and helps them to pursue their education with flexibility.

#### **OBE** consists of 3 Levels:

- a. Level A Equivalent to Class III
- b. Level B Equivalent to Class -V
- c. Level C Equivalent to Class -VIII

After successful completion of Level C we inspire and provide support to appear for Madhyamik (Std. X).

**Therapy** – The main objective of this Unit is to identify the problems of the child through proper intervention and to make them self-sufficient. Following are the types of therapies:


- a. Speech & Language Therapy
- b. Physiotherapy
- c. Occupational Therapy
- d. Sensory Therapy

Apart from the Therapies we also provide Art & Craft, Music, Dance, Psychological Counselling with individual attention.

Currently there are 80 students in our organization for F.Y. 2023-2024. We provide financial and non-financial assistance to the students on demand.
