N. B.

- a School Uniform is important and students should come to the school wearing neat and tidy uniform.
- b Any student not wearing proper uniform or untidy uniform may be refused entry to the school / class.
- c Violation of above directives will be deemed as breach of school discipline and the Principal will be constrained to ask the guardian to withdraw his/her ward, for breach of discipline.



PUNCTUALITY

Students must be punctual in attending their classes .

Parents / guardians are requested to extend their full co-operation to the school authorities in ensuring punctuality of their wards.

Note : Those who come late will not be allowed to enter and attend class without written permission of the Principal / Vice Principal in the School Diary.

SEMESTER

The whole academic year is divided into two semesters.

1st Semester : April to September

2nd Semester : October to March

EXAMINATION

1. Two main Examinations are conducted during the year, one after the first semester and other after second semester.
2. The Pass Mark for each subject to 40%.
3. Promotion may be refused to a student, in case of adaptation of unfair means in any Examination.
4. In the matter of examination and Promotion the decision of the Principal is considered to be final.

WITHDRAWAL OF STUDENTS

A full month's notice or a month's fee is to be paid before withdrawing a student from school.

Urgent fee of Rs. 500/- to be paid for T.C. required within 3 days.

A students failing twice in the same class cannot continue his/her studies in this institution. Parents/ Guardians may be asked to withdraw their ward. Application for Transfer Certificate needs to be made in writing to the Principal.

CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO CLASS XI

1. Candidates who have been awarded Pass Certificate of Secondary Education Examination with passes in five subjects including English and a Second Language are eligible to be admitted for preparation in courses of study leading to the Indian School Certificate Examination.



2. The eligibility of candidates who have been awarded Pass Certificate in an equivalent examination conducted by another Examining Board will be decided by the Chief Executive and Secretary of the Council as per conditions of eligibility.

3. Candidates who pass Class X Examination from Boards other than the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations will be required to pay requisite fee towards Registration / Eligibility Certificates.

N.B. :

- Registration for Provisional Admission will be on the basis of Class X (Selection Test) Performance. The Admission will be finalised after the declaration of ICSE Examination Results.
- Caution fee deposited will be adjusted at the time of Final Admission. However the caution fee will be totally forfeited in case of cancellation of Prov. Admission.
- However, if a student FAIL to acquire the PASS CERTIFICATE from the Council for the said examination in such case the registration will be cancelled automatically and 75% of the caution fee only will be refunded.
- Laboratory Caution Fee (Science Stream) will be refunded after Declaration of Board Examination Result of Class XII
