Minutes of the 879th Regular Weekly Meeting of R. C. Calcutta South City, RID 3291 held at 12:00 pm on Sunday, 29th July, 2012 at "Hotel Senator", 15, Camac Street, Kolkata.

- The Sergeant at Arms, Rtn. Ganesh Bagaria put the collar on Club President, Rtn. Tapas.
- Club President, Rtn. Tapas Kr Mukherjee called the Meeting to Order & welcomed the Rotarians and their family members and Guests present at the meeting
- National Anthem was led by the Children of the Rotarians and Guests present;
- 4. Club President informed the gathering that, Tree plantation campaign as a part of the "Green Magic" Project of the District was held in the morning on 29th July, 2012 at Sahid Bhagat Singh Udyan (Minto Park) and 10 nos. saplings have been planted. Rtn. Pradyumna, Rtn. Sumit, PP Rtn Pulak, PP Rtn Kuldip along with their family members, Rtn Tapas and Rtn. Suranjan Ghosh along with the Belle Vue Clinic Security & Gardening Staff participated in the Plantation Programme. He further updated that under the aforesaid project, more than 1 lac saplings were to be planted at Salt Lake by the District.
- 5. Club President informed the gathering that, he has the following objectives for the forthcoming months:
  - a) RCC Khandalia: Distribution of 300 mosquito nets, Distribution of 1000 saplings; Distribution of approx 300 exercise copies and 150 pens to students who participate in the flag hoisting function; Distribution of 30 school bags, 30 water bottles, 60 pencils, 30 erasers, 30 sharpeners and 20 black slates for the tiny tots attending the Rota School; To provide 2 nos. computers with accessories for the RCC Computer Centre; Facilitate the construction of 2 toilets in the Villag by contributing 75% of the construction cost, not exceeding Rs. 10,000/- per toilet;
  - b) Disha: To support annual school fees of Rs. 450/- per student for 3 students; To support the admission fee of Rs. 4500/- per student for 2 students seeking admission to Class XI; To provide healthy diet to the inmates of the orphanage at a cost of Rs. 2,400/- per month;
  - c) New Ballygunge Balak Sangha: To Support 50 students from economically weaker sections by providing them 2 nos. exercise copies, school bag, pencil box, etc.; To sponsor the blood donation camp to be held on 2nd September, 2012 and also sponsor 100 nos. tiffin for Donors; To distribute clothes to 100 nos. economically weak children of the locality new dresses before the Durga Puja and To distribute 50 nos. of blankets to economically weak senior citizens during winter.
  - d) To sponsor a Outgoing GSE Team member Adrija Sarkar from our club
  - e) To host program for Incoming GSE Team members visit to our club.
- 6. Club Secretary Rtn. Pradyumna Choudhury conducted the Club business.
  - a) Announced that, Rtn. Rathindra Nath Chatterjee has been discharged from Hospital and that, he and Rtn. Tarun Banerjee are recovering at their respective residences;

  - c) He announced that, on 15th August, 2012 independence day will be celebrated at RCC Khandalia and that members should join the programme with their family and make it successful:
