- 1. Meeting called to Order by President.
- 2. The Club President welcomed the members to the Meeting.
- 3. Secretary's Announcements:

- c) Informed the members that, 1<sup>st</sup> Board Meeting of the Club will be held on 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2013 at Hotel Senator at 6.30 pm.
