





KAMAKHYA TEMPLE: The Kamakhya Temple is one of the 108 'Shakti Peethas' making it the most acclaimed Shakti shrines in the country. Perched on the Nilachal Hill and overlooking the West of the Guwahati city, it is one of the most ancient temples in the state. It is dedicated to goddess Sati, an embodiment of goddess Durga and the consort of Lord Shiva. The temple boasts of having medieval style structure that represents contributions of the Koch Royal Family.







Shiva, Sivasagar is one of the popular tourist attractions in Assam. This Upper Assam city has served as the seat of the Ahom for over 6 centuries, so you can expect a lot of Ahom influence in the architecture and culture here. Sivasagar was reckoned as the Golden Land by the Ahoms, who by chance reached this gorgeous place and found it worthy enough to be their power seat. At present, the city is amongst the most important tea and oil trading centres in Assam. Sivasagar is a great place for history lovers. Also, since the city has a fabulous backdrop, photographers are likely to get attracted to it as well. Shivadol, Gaurisagar Tank, Joysagar Tank and Temples, Rang Ghar, Charaideo, Ahom Museum, Talatal Ghar and Gargaon Palace are the tourist attractions in Sivasagar.

SIVASAGAR: Literally meaning The Ocean of Lord

KAZIRANGA: "Kaziranga excites the senses arrests the soul it beckons a wait." Kaziranga national park- a world heritage site, the park hosts 2/3rd of the world's Great One-horned rhinoceros. Kaziranga also boasts the highest density of tigers among the protected areas in the world and was decleared a tiger Reserve in 2006. The park is home to large breeding populations of elephants, wild water buffalo, and swamp deer.





Nameri Natonal Park:

Nameri National Park, located in the foothills of the Eastern Himalayas, in the Sonitpur District of Assam straddles the border between Assam and Arunachal Pradesh. Located 181 km. from Guwahati, it

is just the place for wildlife enthusiasts and nature lovers with its breathtaking natural beauty and diverse flora and fauna. Nameri is a birder's paradise with over 300 species of birds. There is a good prey base in the form of Sambar, Barking deer, Hog Deer, Wild Boar and Gaur. And also a hotspot for Adventure water sports and Angling.

Majuli: The largest river island in the world has beautiful landscapes and gives its visitors a heavenly feeling with its natural beauty. The vaishnavite culture of assam can truly be experienced here which is also very rich with beautiful arts and craftsmanship.
