A 7-year old girl named Anisha Roy has been admitted in Pragati Sangha, the NFE Centre operated by Mass Welfare Society at Panchannagram (East), Kolkata, in January, 2013. Her father does not care for her and often tortures her mother. He is an alcoholic. Every night he comes home drunk and unleashes violence upon the family. He does not contribute anything for the sustenance of his family and often stays away from home for long periods of time.

Anisha’s elder brother got married and went away from home – nobody knows where. Her elder sister studies in a free school run by a charitable organization. Her mother supports the family by working as domestic help in various homes. The family has to bear a lot of suffering because of their poor financial condition. Day by day, it is becoming increasingly difficult for Anisha’s mother to provide for herself and her 2 daughters. Because of this, she is very eager to admit Anisha into a girls’ home and often tells the teachers of MWS about this.

Anisha joined Pragati Sangha on 15th January and has been attending classes regularly since then. Her maternal aunt had brought her to be admitted into the Centre. Currently, Anisha is undergoing non-formal education in the Centre and plans are being made to decide the best course of action for her future betterment.
