Background

Belal Naskar, a boy of 1 year and 7 months lives with his parents and elder sister lives in Dhamua, Diamond Harbour – a remote village area. During a Health Check-Up Camp organized by Mass Welfare Society, it was diagnosed by the Doctor that Belal was suffering from congenital Atrial Septum Disorder, a condition better known as a “Hole in the Heart” and a condition, which, if untreated, can result in the enlargement of the right side of the heart and ultimately heart failure.

Intervention

Mass Welfare Society took up the cause of Belal and made full arrangements for his treatment. The problem was cured through surgery in R. N. Tagore Institute of Cardiac Sciences by a reputed pediatric cardiac surgeon. The boy is now completely out of danger and is full of life and energy like any other child of his age.

Current Status

At present, Belal regularly attends the Preparatory School – Little Flower, run by Mass Welfare Society in its Multipurpose Community Development Centre at Dhamua. He is very enthusiastic about his studies and the staff of Mass Welfare Society continuously motivate him to work towards building a bright future for himself.
